

Important !

In Mexico it is not required Apostille, nor Legalization to the documents that accredits your studies that you studied in a foreign country.

The documents that were issued in a different language than to Spanish should be translated by a simple translation. (It is not required an official expert).

Any Public Educational Office can not refuse your process if you do not have some identification document as: Consular Certification, Migratory Document, Personal Identity Card and Certificate of Nationality and Report Card or Transcript as well.

What to do if your studies are not complete it?

- Find the school where you want that your children continue their studies. They will be located in the appropriate grade according to the general exam that will apply by the administrative area of the school.

What to do if your studies are completed?

- Present the documents that have been mentioned at the closest school near to your neighborhood.
- Ask to the principal's school to do the managements at DRSE (Regional Delegation of Educational Services) for register your child in the database, as soon as possible

Find the closest school of your address or neighborhood.



The documents that you must present:

1. Birth Certificate.
2. CURP.
3. Application Form.
4. Report Card.
5. Transfer.

Transfer? What is that?

The Transfer Document it is designed in English and Spanish, for more acceptance and interpretation, in the schools where your children study, either in Mexico or in EUA.

The transfer it is equivalent as a Evaluation Report Card or Transcript that it is used in the Mexican Educational System.



It is issued in the school where the students studied under request of the students or parents by e-mail or phone call.

It is available in all Consulates of Mexico located in the United States and at the administrative areas of the Mexican Republic as well.



!What you can do if you do not have these documents?

Call to the school where your children studied, so they have to send you the records and reports cards of the grades that they had been completed, by an email.



If your children are in the Basic Level of Education

- Preschool
- Elementary School
- Middle School / Junior High

Follow these steps:

1. Find the closest school to your address or neighborhood.
2. Present the documents to the principal's school.
3. Support and make a compromise with the principal school in order to complete the file or documentation of your children.
4. Take your children to the school.

Remember:

!If you do not have some document required, it is not an impediment for your children to get a registration or renewal their registration!

Do you know what means to revalidate the studies of Basic Education?

It is awarded official validity to studies that your children had finished in other country, as long as they are comparable and equivalent with those are implemented in the Mexican Educational System.
